## Key Healthcare Challenges in India



- Rural vs Urban Divide
  - <70% of India's 1.2 billion population still lives in rural areas.
- Skewed Doctor-Patient ratio.
  - Specialist doctors are restricted to the metro and class-A cities
- Lack of awareness
  - Vast variations in literacy causing & disease burden



- Paper systems appear more reliable
  - Fear of technology failing.
- Lack of national standards
  - Reluctance of medical, nursing levels and other staff to change.



- Rise in chronic & lifestyle-based conditions.
  - Low emphasis on disease prevention
- Absence of a system that seeks to manage the chronic condition patients as a group
